

Beswick Road Community Park

The groundwork has been started on the community park. All approvals have been received from the various government agencies to allow the work to go ahead, The site survey has been completed, the License of Occupation received and environmental and archeological studies completed.

The first part of the development of the park has been completed with the right of way opened up to the full width of 66 ft. This required that immature trees and brush were removed leaving the mature trees in place nearer the water to allow for shade and esthetics. The roadway has been graveled to create a large parking area.

A vaulted toilet has been installed that blends in very well with the surrounding trees that were left to provide privacy. This piece of infrastructure is an asset that will surely improve the functionality of this park.

The remainder of the landscaping including placement of picnic tables, benches, and fire pit, will be completed in the spring.

In addition a memorial bench is planned in memory of Bonnie Grant.
