

Don Fink Field And Recreation Area



The Don Fink Field is an area used by the community for recreation. It is used in the spring, summer and fall and finds most use by both tourists and local residents during the summer including the Summer Sizzler weekend which brings up to 3000 people to Seymour Arm during the August long weekend. It has the following recreational uses within its boundaries.

1. Baseball Field including bleachers and score board. This field is one of two baseball field located at Seymour Arm. The other being by the community hall.
2. Volleyball courts. There are two beach type volleyball courts end to end.
3. Horseshoe pitch area. It is used for open competition and friendly games mainly on Sunday but also is used to a lesser extent during the week. There is an annual tournament held on the July long weekend which draws competitors from the North Shuswap area.
4. There are two sets of swings for the children to use.
5. There are limited picnic facilities including tables for community and visitor use.
6. There are also open pit toilets available for those that need to use them.
7. Water purification shed in which potable water is available to all that need it.

This field area is located near the community wharf and is readily available for daytime boat use along with community use.
