Available are a propane stove, electric fridge two large double sinks, great coffee makers for large groups, there is also a food preparation and storage area adjacent to the kitchen. You can serve your guests right from the prep/cooking area to the main hall. Some pots and pans and some dishes are available. SACA also owns a large BBQ which can be made available. Hall rental on a daily or hourly basis is available. The hall was built in 1971. The property on which the hall stands was owned by the Daniels Family who are a pioneer family in the area and who, in 1999 donated the land to the people of Seymour Arm. We are currently in the process of enlarging and renovating the hall. The Community Association runs this hall and the area surrounding it on behalf of the citizens of Seymour Arm. Maintenance of the hall and its surrounding environs is mainly done through donations, through volunteer labor and donations of equipment for the benefit of the people of Seymour Arm. That is still the mandate of the Community Hall Management Committee, but added they have also as an object to promote and advance the interests of harmony, fellowship and community development in our community.

Great parking for all your guests is located right on the main road and in the field surrounding the hall. The hall is easy to find for your out-of-town guests. There is also lots of field space for the kids in your party to run and play. The Hall is available for anniversaries, weddings, family reunions and meetings.
